

WALKING THE CAMINO

DE SANTIAGO

(Shorter distances)



- Beautiful wooded landscapes of Galicia.
- Enjoy travelling with other pilgrims of many nationalities as you wish to each other "*Buen camino*" on your way to Santiago de Compostela.
- Explore the mythical city of Santiago de Compostela on your emotional arrival to Plaza de Obradoiro.

A different version of the final 113 kms of the classic Camino de Santiago covering less kilometres each day. From the Galician town of Sarria join other pilgrims on "the way" as you soak up the history and folklore that surrounds this legendary pilgrimage.





ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival to Sarria.

Arrival to Sarria, the start of your Camino and a chance to explore the town.

Day 2: Sarria - Portomarin.

23km / Climb: 300m

Set off on the Camino amongst ancient oak, birch and chestnut forest and later walk through many hamlets dotted around areas of cultivated land and grazing pastures along quiet country lanes and natural pathways.



Day 3: Portomarin - Lestedo.

20km / Climb: 450m

Pine forests, corn fields, meadows and oak and chestnut woodland accompanies you on this stretch of the Camino. You will also cross a number of small villages full of rural character.

Day 4: Lestedo - Melide.

20km / Climb: 100m

You will cross 6 river valleys along secluded pathways through mature woodland. The area is full of medieval castles as well as Romanesque churches and settlements.

Day 5: Melide - Arzua.

14km / Climb: 90m

A short stage walking amongst woodland, meadows and small orchards near the many small villages you go through.

Day 6: Arzua - Rua.

18km / Climb: 160m

The Camino weaves its way towards Santiago amongst forests and agricultural fields with many ups and downs as rivers cross from north to south.

Day 7: Rua - Santiago.

23km / Climb: 120m

The last stage. The first few km through dense eucalyptus forest, then the long climb up to Monte Gozo and finally enter the historical city to make your way towards the famed Cathedral.

Day 8: Departure or extra nights.

Departure or extra nights in Santiago.

ACCOMMODATION

Six small hotels in the Camino itself of two to three stars standard. In Santiago one night in centrally located small hotel.

We also offer two more versions of El Camino: 14 days from Astorga and the Full French Camino from Roncesvalles. Contact us for more information.



HOLIDAY INFORMATION

DURATION: 8 days, 7 nights.

ACTIVITY LEVEL: Moderate+.

AVERAGE DAILY DISTANCE: 20km.

CLIMB: 147m.

RECOMMENDED TIME OF YEAR: April to end of October.

START: Any day of the week.

HOW TO GET THERE: Fly to Santiago Airport and take a bus to Sarria or book a private transfer with us.

WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- 7 nights' accommodation in a room with its own bathroom.
- 7 breakfasts and 6 dinners.
- Luggage transfers between hotels (1 item of luggage per person).
- Detailed maps and roadbook.
